

Roger's Run

Major Otto Rogers took three companies of the 1st Bn, 7th Marines to the aid of Lt. Col. Griffith's Marine Raider Battalion. Rogers landed on the wrong side of the Matanikau, finding himself cut off from both Griffith and Lt. Col. Puller's 7th Marines. With strong fire support from the destroyer Monssen, the stranded Marines made it back to the beach; but Rogers himself never did.

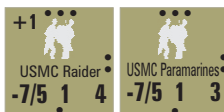

(set up in any hill hex)



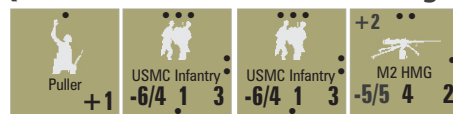
Map 1-B

(set up west of the river)

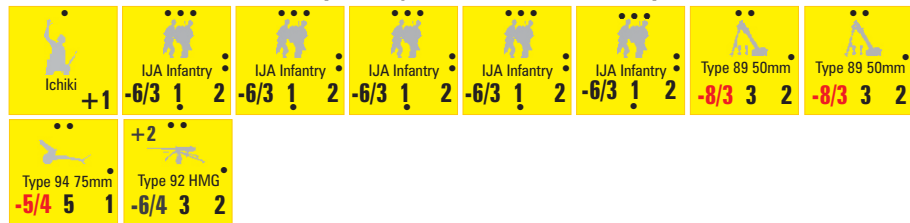


Force C

SPECIAL: No units may begin the game DUG IN. US Force A units may retreat off of the North edge of the board at any time; such units are removed from play, but not considered destroyed.
